

# MPP At A Glance

- The Department of Defense (DoD) Pilot MPP was established under Section 831 of Public Law 101-510, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1991.
- Created to provide incentives for DoD contractors to assist small businesses in enhancing their capabilities and increasing their participation in government and commercial contracts.

# MPP Regulatory Update

## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

- The DoD MPP has not been re-authorized. The current authorization allows for execution of new agreements through September 30, 2018.

# MPP Why Participate?

## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### Benefits to DoD:

- Stimulate and transition innovative technologies into established Defense Acquisition programs;
- Resolve operational challenges and other critical national security requirements; and,
- Provides developmental and technical assistance to Protégé for potential business opportunities with DoD agencies and other federal agencies.

#### **Mentor Benefits:**

- Develop long-term business relationships with Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB) concerns;
- Develop SDB subcontracting base; and,
- Teaming opportunities with the Protégé to win new contracts and/or subcontracts.

#### Protégé Benefits:

- Relevant technical assistance;
- Teaming opportunities with Mentor to win new contracts and/or subcontracts; and,
- DoD long-term Industrial Base partnership.







# MPP Who Can Participate?

## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### The Mentor:

- Be eligible for award of a Federal contract
- Must Demonstrate:
  - Qualified to provide assistance;
  - In good financial health and character; and,
  - Is not on debarred/suspended list.
- Evidence of capability to impart value to a protégé
  - Received DoD contracts totaling at least \$100M in previous fiscal year;
  - Is other than small entity (can be waived); and,
  - Prime contractor with an active subcontracting plan; or,
  - Is an 8(a) graduate with documentation of its ability to serve as a Mentor.

# MPP Who Can Participate?

## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### The Protégé:

- Small Business Concern;
- Eligible for award of Federal contracts;
- Less than half the Small Business Administration (SBA) size standard for primary NAICS;
- Not owned by individual/entity with stock options/securities in Mentor; and,
- Be at least one of the following:
  - Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB);
  - Women-Owned Small Business (WOSB);
  - HUBZone Small Business (HUBZone);
  - Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB);
  - A business employing the severely disabled;
  - A business owned and controlled by a Native American tribe;
  - A business owned and controlled by a Native Hawaiian Organization; or,
  - An entity providing goods/services in private sector critical to enhancing DoD supplier base.







## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### Types of Mentor-Protégé Agreements (MPA)s

- 1. Reimbursable Provide monetary reimbursement only for the cost of developmental assistance incurred by the Mentor firm and provided to a Protégé firm in accordance with the approved agreement.
- 2. Credit Credit agreements allow a Mentor to receive credit toward subcontracting goals for costs incurred.
- **Hybrid** Hybrid agreements are a combination of both the reimbursable agreement and the credit agreement. One year must be Credit and the other one - two years must be Reimbursable. The Credit/Reimbursable years can be arranged based on the recommended approach of the Mentor and Protégé. Developmental assistance costs may only be incurred after receipt of an approval letter from DCMA.






## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### General Procedures

- 1. Mentors must choose a protégé
- 2. Mentors must identify Major Buying Command (MBC)
- 3. MBC determines contracting method
  - a. Stand-alone contract
  - b. Modifying an existing contract
- 4. Mentor Schedules Informal Introductory Briefing
- 5. Mentor Submits Mentor Protégé Agreement Proposal Package







## Department of the Navy Office of Small Business Programs

#### Proposal Package

- 1. Must specify how the developmental program will:
  - a. Increase ability to participate in DoD contracting;
  - b. Increase subcontracting opportunities; and,
  - c. Address identified needs to enhance ability to perform.

#### 2. Must contain:

- a. Executive Summary;
- b. The Mentor Protégé Agreement;
- c. Benefits Statement/Return On Investment document;
- d. Technical Proposal; and,
- e. Cost Proposal.
