LS2 Aguilaromero is the Supply Department Lead Petty Officer for the Navy Munitions Command Pacific CONUS West, Seal Beach, California. LS2 Aguilaromero was deployed to ISA Bahrain from May 2021 to April 2022. As a newly frocked LS2, she demonstrated outstanding leadership as she managed to bring the base up to a 12-crane vehicle caravan while simultaneously working after hours to build a tent city for the refugees that had escaped Afghanistan. She helped facilitate the safe transit of 7,079 US Citizens, making her a recipient of the humanitarian Ribbon Award. As LPO of the postal center she managed the processing of over 12 tons of mail. She promoted esprit de corps to the command diversity committee by planning Latin dance events for the base, incorporating Army, Marine Corp, and Navy service members. Her commitment to be a leader and execution of hard work has

nominated her as the Junior Soldier of Quarter, 3rd Quarter, FY 2023. LS2 Aguilaromero volunteers in the 5K and volleyball events at Los Angeles Air Force Base and encourages other sailors to join. LS2 Aguilaromero has initiated a Junior Enlisted Mess for all Petty Officer Second Classes within the command to enhance comradery and assist junior sailors. Logistics Specialist First Class Emperatriz Rodriguez, USN

LS1 Rodriguez is the Leading Petty Officer for the Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron Eighty Five Detachment Two, Kadena Air Base, Japan, where she led 39 Sailors in 8 work centers across 3 geographic areas, completing maintenance on forward-deployed MH-60S aircraft. Under her leadership, the unit completed 3,892 maintenance actions and five inspections. Those actions aided in the mishap-free execution of 256 flight hours, 80 operational sorties, and a 100% Full Mission Capable rate with zero safety of flight incidents. Through her supervision, 180 Urgent Material Screening Messages and 186 Work Stoppages were transmitted, directly contributing to the requisition of components vital to the completion of 3 Major Phase Inspections. LS1 Rodriguez also orchestrated and led 4 sailors in providing breakfast on 5 different occasions while forward deployed to Osan Air Base due to mission requirements interfering with galley hours. As Duty Section Leader, she led 6

sailors and maintained a comprehensive watch bill for 30 personnel, ensuring watch stations were fully qualified. She also conducted training with 47 Sailors to ensure their development into future leaders. In her civilian job, LS1 is a postal clerk for the U.S. Postal Service. She volunteered at the Kadena Air Base USO. Her exceptional performance as a drilling reservist, a postal clerk, and volunteer service over the past year echoes the Navy's core values of honor, courage, and commitment and exemplifies the actions and spirit of the Twice A Citizen Award.



Senior Airman Gabriel David Nogalez, USAF

SrA Gabriel Nogalez serves as an Aerial Porter at the 56th Aerial Port Squadron, March Air Reserve Base, California, where his responsibilities included the safe and timely loading of cargo onto aircraft to ensure rapid global mobility operations and safety of flight for joint training missions. He was handpicked to maintain a special certification as a Load Planner to ensure the safety of flights, maximize aircraft utilization rates, and reduce cargo hold times. Airman Nogalez deployed to Operation ALLIES WELCOME where he supported the \$820 million Presidential Aid package for the relocation of 16,000 Afghan refugees. Providing transportation support, he safeguarded over 18,000 lodging pods and 45 essential buildings over a 2,000-mile patrol. He served as a cultural ambassador which allowed foreign nationals to enhance relations with the U.S. Senior Airman Nogalez also volunteered for a short-notice tasking to transport 50 artillery systems, eight aircraft, and 300 tons of supplies, resolving key Ukrainian war material shortages. As a civilian, Senior Airman Nogalez is a Sales Advisor for Compass Realty. For his community, he is a pastor, serving troubled young men and he participates in outreach programs for the homeless. His exceptional performance as a drilling reservist, efforts in his civilian job, and volunteer service over the past year echoes the Air Force's core values of integrity first, service before self, and excellence in all we do and exemplifies the actions and spirit of the Twice A Citizen Award.



Aviation Machinist's Mate First Class Moises Rodriguez, USN

AD1 Rodriguez is the Selected Reserve Lead Petty Officer and Full Systems Quality Assurance Representative for the Fleet Logistics Support Squadron 57 (VR-57), San Diego, CA, where he led 48 Sailors performing safety of maintenance inspections on C-40A aircraft. His diligent efforts enabled 112 Quality Assurance required maintenance actions, resulting in the timely movement of 524 passengers and 125,000 pounds of cargo, totaling 1,691 flight hours across 5 OCONUS Detachments in support of Department of Defense logistics operations with a 98% mission completion rate. AD1 Moises Rodriguez is a two-time Selected Reserve Sailor of the Year at VR-57. AD1 Rodriguez's squadron was awarded the Fiscal Year 2022 Battle Efficiency Award in large part to his exemplary performance and leadership.
